

Steps to prepare for COVID-19 vaccines

1 Check the vaccine schedule

COVID-19 Vaccinations for **senior citizens** start sequentially beginning with **residents in elderly care facilities**.

The starting period for vaccination appointments for general senior citizens will be announced later through the city news and other publications.

* The information will also be available on the official Shibuya City website and the Shibuya City COVID-19 Vaccination Call Center.

* Vaccine distribution may take a little longer depending on the situation, but please be assured that it will be supplied sequentially to all COVID-19 vaccine applicants. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

2 Decide on the medical institution/vaccine site

Please check the official Shibuya City site, Shibuya City news, or call the Shibuya City COVID-19 Vaccination Call Center for information about the medical institutions or vaccination sites where you can receive the vaccination.

* Except for persons who are hospitalized or in care facilities, the vaccines will be administered in the municipality (city, ward, town, village) where you are registered as a resident. For vaccinations at a different location outside of the address on your Residence Card, please see the reverse.

3 Book your vaccination appointment

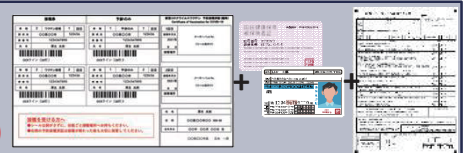

* If you are trying to book an appointment and none are available because of limited COVID-19 vaccine doses, more appointments will be added every time a new supply becomes available. The vaccines are expected to arrive two or three times each month.

What to bring on your appointment day

- 1. Vaccination coupon (enclosed in the notice letter)
- 2. Identity verification documents (driver's license, health insurance card, etc.)
- 3. Prevaccination Screening Questionnaire (enclosed in the notice letter)



* **The vaccination process takes about an hour** (including the pre-vaccination consultation and postvaccination observation time)

* **The Prevaccination Screening Questionnaire shall be handed in on the day of your appointment; please be sure to read through the vaccination instructions and complete the information for the vaccine recipient (except for body temperature) and the questionnaire before your visit.**

* Before leaving for the vaccination site, please take your temperature. If it is much higher than your normal range or if you are not feeling well, please contact the Shibuya City COVID-19 vaccination call center to reschedule your appointment.

* The enclosed coupon sheet contains the vaccination certificate and vaccination coupons for two appointments. Please bring it with you to each appointment without cutting off each one.

◎ Eligible senior citizens

Senior citizens aged 65 or older during the fiscal year 2021 (those who were born on or before April 1, 1957) are eligible for the vaccinations.

◎ Appropriate clothing for the vaccination

The vaccines will be injected in the upper arm. Since rolling up a long sleeved shirt does not provide easy access to your upper arm for the vaccination, please wear clothes that are easy to remove and put on. We appreciate your cooperation. Also, we recommend dressing in layers by wearing a T-shirt or sleeveless top underneath.

Since you need to have a medical examination, any (one-piece) dress or coveralls should be avoided. Also, please avoid high-heeled shoes to protect the floor from scratches.

◎ Vaccinations at different locations outside the address provided on your resident register

- If you will be vaccinated at a medical institution or facility where you are hospitalized or admitted ➡ Please consult the medical institution or facility.
- If you will be vaccinated at a medical institution where you are hospitalized for treatment of an underlying disease ➡ Please consult the medical institution.
- If your current location differs from the address on your Residence Card ➡ You may be able to receive this vaccination in the municipality where you actually live.

◎ Vaccinations will only be provided to consenting individuals

If you are undergoing treatment for a disease or have concerns about the vaccination due to your health condition, please decide whether to receive the vaccine upon consultation with your doctor.

◎ Appointment service desks for senior citizens

The appointment service desks are open at the facilities below to support senior citizens during the vaccination period prioritized for senior citizens. The appointment service desks are generally open on a once-a-week basis. Operators make appointments using a system on behalf of those who do not know how to use the dedicated website for COVID-19 vaccines. The open days and hours will be announced through the Shibuya City news and other updates.

* Utilizing the service desk or doing it on your own through the dedicated website or by telephone, the appointment order will be the same.
