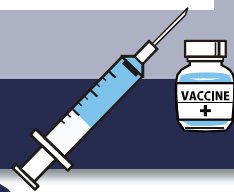

Steps to prepare for COVID-19 vaccines

1 Check the available vaccine (appointment) schedule

Even after receiving your coupon sheet (vaccination coupons), appointments cannot be made until the designated period.

The available vaccine (appointment) schedule for you can be checked as follows:

* Priority vaccinations are available for those under 60 years of age with underlying medical conditions or working as a nursing care worker at elderly facilities. 2 Decide on the medical institution/vaccine site

3 Book your vaccination appointment

- Your vaccination coupon number and date of birth (AD) will be needed for appointments. Please have your coupon sheet (vaccination coupons) ready.
- Depending on the availability of appointments, you may not be able to book an appointment at the vaccination site of your choice.
- You must also book the second vaccination appointment by yourself.

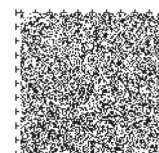
What to bring on your appointment day

- 1. Coupon sheet (vaccination coupons) (enclosed in the notice letter)
- 2. Identity verification documents (driver's license, health insurance card, etc.)
- 3. Prevaccination Screening Questionnaire (enclosed in the notice letter)

- The vaccination process takes about an hour (including the pre-vaccination consultation and postvaccination observation time)
- The Prevaccination Screening Questionnaire shall be handed in on the day of your appointment; please be sure to read through the vaccination instructions and complete the information for the vaccine recipient (except for body temperature) and the questionnaire before your visit.
- Before leaving for the vaccination site, please take your temperature. If it is much higher than your normal range or if you are not feeling well, please contact the Shibuya City COVID-19 vaccination call center to reschedule your appointment.
- The enclosed coupon sheet contains the vaccination certificate and vaccination coupons for two appointments. Please bring it with you to each appointment without cutting off each one.

◎Types of vaccines

It is necessary that you get the same type of COVID-19 vaccine for the first and second doses.

The Shibuya City uses the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine for the vaccinations while the large-scale national vaccination centers offer the Moderna or Takeda vaccine. (As of May 31)

◎Second vaccination appointment

The Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine we apply requires that you get your second shot three weeks after the first as a rule. If you are receiving the second dose after three weeks, please book your appointment no later than six weeks after the first shot.

You can book more recent day as the first if there is a 3-weeks interval to the date you've already appointed.

You can book the second vaccination before you receive the first dose.

◎Appropriate clothing for the vaccination

The vaccines will be injected in the upper arm. Since rolling up a long sleeved shirt does not provide easy access to your upper arm for the vaccination, please wear clothes that are easy to remove and put on. We appreciate your cooperation. Also, we recommend dressing in layers by wearing a T-shirt or sleeveless top underneath.

Since you need to have a medical examination, any (one-piece) dress or coveralls should be avoided. Also, please avoid high-heeled shoes to protect the floor from scratches.



◎Your consent is required to receive the vaccine

If you are undergoing treatment for a disease or have concerns about the vaccination due to your health condition, please decide whether to receive the vaccine upon consultation with your doctor.

◎Vaccination at places other than the place where the resident card is registered (place of residence)

- If you will be vaccinated at a medical institution or facility where you are hospitalized or admitted ➡ Please consult the medical institution or facility.
- If you will be vaccinated at a medical institution where you are hospitalized for treatment of an underlying disease ➡ Please consult the medical institution.
- If your current location differs from the address on your Residence Card ➡ You may be able to receive this vaccination in the municipality where you actually live.
