Shibuya City Comprehensive Disaster Prevention Drills

1. Various Programs Put On by Disaster Prevention-Related Organizations

The community residents and organizations related to disaster prevention will cooperate to teach residents about situations that arise after an earthquake strikes and what countermeasures we must take. The drills will be split into three sections depending on the passage of time after the initial disaster.

Program

1. Initial post-disaster response drills

- ShakeOut drills
- Confirm safety and gathering information
- Initial firefighting drill, and more

2. Disaster prevention organization response drills

- Drills for combating fires that have spread within the city
- Rescue and relief drills
- Disaster medical response drill, and more

3. Recovery and aid drills

- Emergency risk determination training
- Road education training
- Critical infrastructure recovery training



Drills for combating fires that have spread within the city

On the day of the drills, the public-address system will broadcast chimes to signal that an earthquake has struck.

8:05 a.m.: An announcement that an earthquake has struck is made.

8:30 a.m.: Orders to evacuate are issued.
